All secondary schools from across the Sheffield City Region have been invited to attend with their Year 11, Year 12 and Year 13 students who are interested in apprenticeships as a possible route in the future.

This event aims to offer a new approach by helping students to understand the breadth of apprenticeship opportunities available to them, by talking directly to employers looking to recruit young people in the Summer 2020.

Over 50 employers from Sheffield, Rotherham, Barnsley, North East Derbyshire, Chesterfield, Bolsover and Bassetlaw have already confirmed their attendance and will be ready to discuss their job vacancies (apprenticeship, degree apprenticeship and school leaver programmes) with potential candidates.

We plan to take a group of students who are interested in the apprenticeship route in the future to the event. Your child is expected to leave school promptly at 12.35 pm (after Period 3) and make their own way independently to Cutlers Hall for 1.15-1.30 pm. It is important that they go straight to the venue because Silverdale School has a booked 'slot' from 1.30 pm onwards until 3 pm when students are able to leave and make their own way home.

If your child would like to attend, it is essential that they bring an industry specific C.V. to hand to employers at the event.
