Dear Parent/Carer

Walk and Picnic Activity Wednesday 17 July 2019 – Route 4

On Wednesday 17th July 2019, your child will be going on the Walk and Picnic trip. **Students are required to meet staff in the main hall at 08.45am.** Students will then catch the bus to Fox House and will walk along a predetermined route where the start and finish is at Fox House. As such, students will need return bus fare, which is £1.60 (80p each way). This is all the costs involved in this trip. About half way along the route, students and staff will stop for a picnic and some games and then carry along the route back to Fox House where they will catch the bus back to school. Students will be back in school by approximately 4pm.

Students are required to bring their own packed lunch for the picnic. Students who receive free school meals will get a packed lunch provided for them. As a precaution, we ask students to be mindful of the weather and bring their own sun cream and also waterproofs. Attire for the day must be PE style clothes and either walking boots or trainers. Students who do not wear the appropriate footwear will not be allowed to go on the walk and instead will remain in school. This is to avoid injury and ensure the Health and Safety of students.

As all the other trips are now full and the deadline for payment has been and gone, the only alternative if you would not like your child to go on this trip is for them to stay in school with a member of staff.
