Activity Week Trip Choices – Wednesday 17th July 2019

Please find attached information about the Activity Week trip choices. The payment window will be open from Friday 17th May at 9.00 until Monday 3rd June. Please complete the reply slip and return it in an envelope with cash or cheque made payable to Silverdale School for the appropriate amount clearly marked with the student's name & form, Activity Week Trips - even if you choose the free Walk & Picnic option - to Student Reception by Monday 3rd June 2019.

You will be informed as soon as a trip is full if you need to make a second choice. Unfortunately, we were unable to run the swimming and cinema trip. Please pay for one trip per child only.





Trip 1 – Rother Valley Country Park – mountain biking and archery with an instructor - £25.00 (20 places)

Students make their own way to Rother Valley Country Park, S26 5PQ (parental drop-off or public transport by tram), arriving for 9.30. The first session is 10.00-11.30 (mountain biking or archery). The second session is 12.30-2.00 (mountain biking or archery). Parents are responsible for arranging transport for their children to and from the park. Students should bring a packed lunch, waterproofs and sun cream. Trip cost includes two activities.





Trip 2 – Ice skating and high ropes climbing activity - £9.00 (80 places)

Students make their own way to Ice Sheffield, S9 5DA (parental drop-off or public transport), arriving for 9.30. During the day, students will take part in two activities: ice skating on the rink and instructor-led climbing using ropes on the Altitude activity. Please note that the ice skating is a public session. Parents are responsible for arranging transport

for their children to and from Ice Sheffield. Students should bring a packed lunch, waterproofs and sun cream. Trip cost includes two activities.





Trip 3 - Yorkshire Wildlife Park - £20.00 (170 places)

Students arrive at school by 9.00 and take a coach to Yorkshire Wildlife Park. Visit includes an Educational Talk. Return to school around 3.30. Students should bring a packed lunch, waterproofs and sun cream.





Trip 4 – York (York Dungeon and exploring the city) – £21.00 (130 places)

Students arrive at school by 8.30 and take a coach to York. Spend half the day visiting York Dungeon and the other half exploring the historic city centre. Return to school around 4.00. Students should bring a packed lunch, waterproofs and sun cream.



Trip 5 – Walk and picnic – no cost

This trip runs on normal school day times. Students should bring a packed lunch, waterproofs and sun cream.



Trip 6 – Tree House Board Games café (only open to members of the Dice club – 25 places) – payment on arrival Please see separate letters about the Tree House Board Games trip or contact Mr Rooke for more details (drooke@silverdale-chorustrust.org).



Trip 7 – London Performing Arts Trip – fully booked – 39 places
