Information only - Trips in Activity Week (Wednesday 17th July)

We have our school Activity Week in the last week of term (15th-19th July). Students will take part in different lessons and activities, including sports, workshops and competitions.

On Wednesday 17th July, all KS3 students will be out of school on a trip. The options, following consultation with School Council, are below. Students have been given the options in assembly and have had time to discuss their preferences in form time.

A letter with more details about each trip will be sent after the two-week holiday. Payments will be taken on ParentPay or cheque made payable to Silverdale School/cash from **Monday 29th April – Friday 10th May**. Please note the Performing Arts trip to London has a separate deadline.

I have given an approximate price for each trip to help families plan for payment. If you have any concerns about managing the cost of the trip for your child, please contact me in confidence on the email below.

1. Yorkshire Wildlife Park (travel by coach) – around £22
2. London - Performing Arts (travel by coach) – around £200
3. Outdoor sports – Rother Valley (students make their own way there by public transport) – around £15
4. Walk and picnic – (walking from school) - no cost
5. Ice skating and high ropes (students make their own way there by public transport) – around £12
6. Swimming and cinema – (students make their own way there by public transport) – around £10
7. York – Dungeon Museum and shopping (travel by train) – around £20

There will also be a trip to the Board Games café for members of the Board Games Club, which meets on a Wednesday after school. The cost of this will be under £5. Please contact Mr Rooke for more details.
