The skeleton of a girl, dressed in red velvet, was found shut in an old chest. When strange things start happening, Elly decides to solve the ancient mystery.</p>
	<p>Lockwood and Co by Jonathan Stroud</p> <p>AR Book Level 5.1</p>	<p>In the world of Lockwood &amp; Co., only children can see the ghostly spectres that haunt the modern world and so it's down to them to hunt them out. Young hero Lockwood combines an impulsive nature with a genius brain, which make him rather a clever ghost sleuth - if somewhat unlucky in business. 	<p>I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings by Maya Angelou</p> <p>AR Book Level 6.7</p>	<p>One of America's most important classics, Maya Angelou beautifully evokes her childhood with her grandmother in the American south of the 1930s.</p>
	<p>Holes by Louis Sachar</p> <p>AR Book Level 4.6</p>	<p>When Stanley Yelnats is falsely accused of stealing a pair of trainers, he is sent off to Camp Green Lake which is not a camp, not green and not near a lake but a boys' detention centre in the middle of the desert. An original and funny page-turner with a great plot.</p>
	<p>Northern Lights by Philip Pullman</p> <p>AR Book Level 6.2</p>	<p>Lyra Belacqua and her animal daemon live half-wild and carefree among scholars of Jordan College, Oxford.</p> <p>The destiny that awaits her will take her to the frozen lands of the Arctic, where witch-clans reign and ice-bears fight.</p> <p>Her extraordinary journey will have immeasurable consequences far beyond her own world...</p>

	<p>The Hound of the Baskervilles by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle</p> <p>AR Book Level 8.3</p>	<p>Sherlock Holmes stars in Doyle's most famous detective story of the infamous Sherlock Holmes and Dr Watson as they investigate the mysterious death of Sir Charles Baskerville, whose dead body is found on the misty and desolate Devon moors.</p>
	<p>Peter Pan by J. M. Barrie</p> <p>AR Book Level 7.7</p>	<p>Poignant and unforgettable, J. M. Barrie's classic tale is one of the greatest works of children's literature of the last century. Its imaginative scope, tender humour and vivid characters will enchant adults and children alike.</p>
	<p>Anne of Green Gables by L. M. Montgomery</p> <p>AR Book Level 7.3</p>	<p>This treasured coming-of-age story chronicles the journey of a little red-headed orphan, Anne Shirley, as she struggles to settle into her new life on Prince Edward Island, Canada. Initially published in 1908, Lucy Maud Montgomery brings the quick-witted and vividly imaginative Anne to life incorporating themes of friendship, nature, morality and ambition.</p>
	<p>Finn Family Moomintroll by Tove Jansson</p> <p>AR Book Level 5.2</p>	<p>In case you didn't know, the Moomins are kind, loyal and welcoming creatures with smooth round snouts, who live in a tall blue house shaped like an old stove in a valley in the forests of Finland. They love sunshine and sleep right through the winter, when the snow turns their house into a great snowball. Full of gentle surrealism and wisdom.</p>




Granny then breaks the devastating news that all three Widdershins sisters are trapped by an ancient curse and if they ever leave Crowstone, they will die by the following sunrise. A tale of witches, magic and family.</p>
	<p>Magnus Chase and the Sword of Summer by Rick Riordan</p> <p>AR Book Level 4.8</p>	<p>Magnus Chase has always been a troubled kid, surviving by his wits, keeping one step ahead of the law. The Viking myths are true, and the gods of Asgard are preparing for war...</p>
	<p>The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins</p> <p>AR Book Level 5.3</p>	<p>Set in a dark vision of the near future, the Tributes -twelve boys and twelve girls - are forced to appear in a live event called The Hunger Games. There is only one rule: kill or be killed. Katniss and fellow District 12 Tribute, Peeta, become pawns in a complex political game in this scarily believable, highly addictive dystopian vision.</p>
	<p>The Wee Free Men by Terry Pratchett</p> <p>AR Book Level 4.7</p>	<p>Now that Granny Aching has gone, there's only young Tiffany Aching left to guard the boundaries. Luckily she has some very unusual help: the local Nac Mac Feegle – aka the Wee Free Men – a clan of fierce, sheep-stealing, sword-wielding, six-inch-high blue men. Together they must face headless horsemen, ferocious grimhounds, terrifying dreams, and ultimately the sinister Queen of the Elves herself . . .</p>

	<p>Eragon by Christopher Paolini</p> <p>AR Book Level 5.6</p>	<p>When poor farm boy Eragon finds a polished stone in the forest, he thinks it's a lucky discovery. Perhaps, he will be able to buy his family food for the winter. But, when a baby dragon hatches out of the stone, Eragon realises he's stumbled upon a legacy nearly as old as the Empire itself. Fans of the Lord of the Rings and Northern Lights will love the magic, power and the storytelling.</p>
	<p>Summoner: The Novice By Taran Matharu</p> <p>AR Book Level 6.5</p>	<p>The Summoner Trilogy is the story of Fletcher, an orphan who lives in the small village of Pelt, not far from the elfen border and the farthest outpost in an on-going war against the orcs. Despite being a skilled hunter and apprentice blacksmith, Fletcher has little status in the village but a chance encounter leads to Fletcher discovering that he has the rare ability to summon demons from another world...</p>
	<p>The Starlight Watchmaker by Lauren James</p> <p>AR Book Level 4.8</p>	<p>The clock is ticking and, with each minute that passes, the whole academy sinks deeper into danger... Can an unlikely friendship between android and student save the day? A wildly imaginative sci-fi adventure from YA star Lauren James.</p>
	<p>Valkyrie by Kate O'Hearn</p> <p>AR Book Level: 4.3</p>	<p>Freya is dreading turning fourteen, which marks the official end of her childhood and when she takes up full duties of a Valkyrie - a collector of souls from humanity's battlefields. She tries to understand what it is to be human: to make friends with people her own age, without the fear of causing their death with one touch.
